then we take the register.



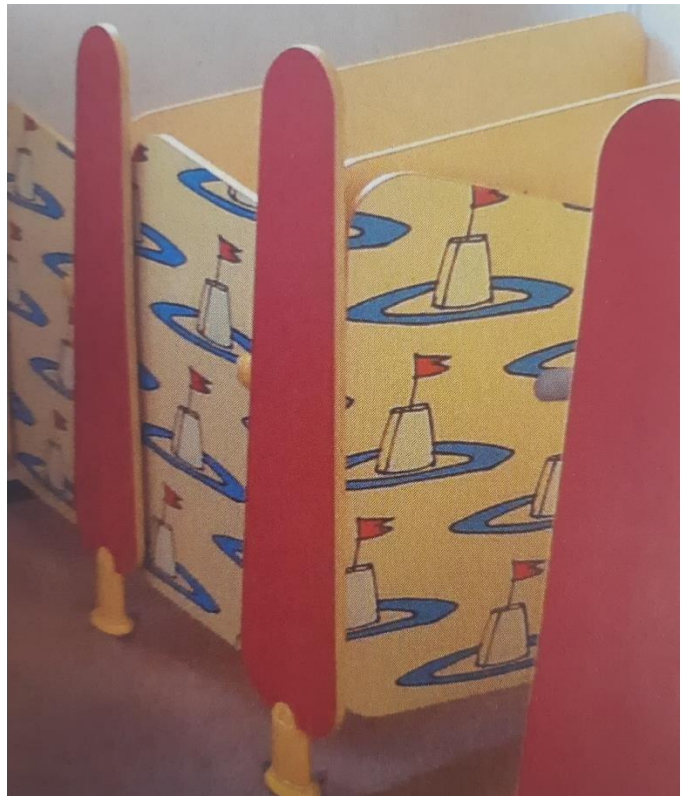
The Hall

Next to the cloakroom there are separate bathrooms for boys and girls, for using the toilet and washing our hands.

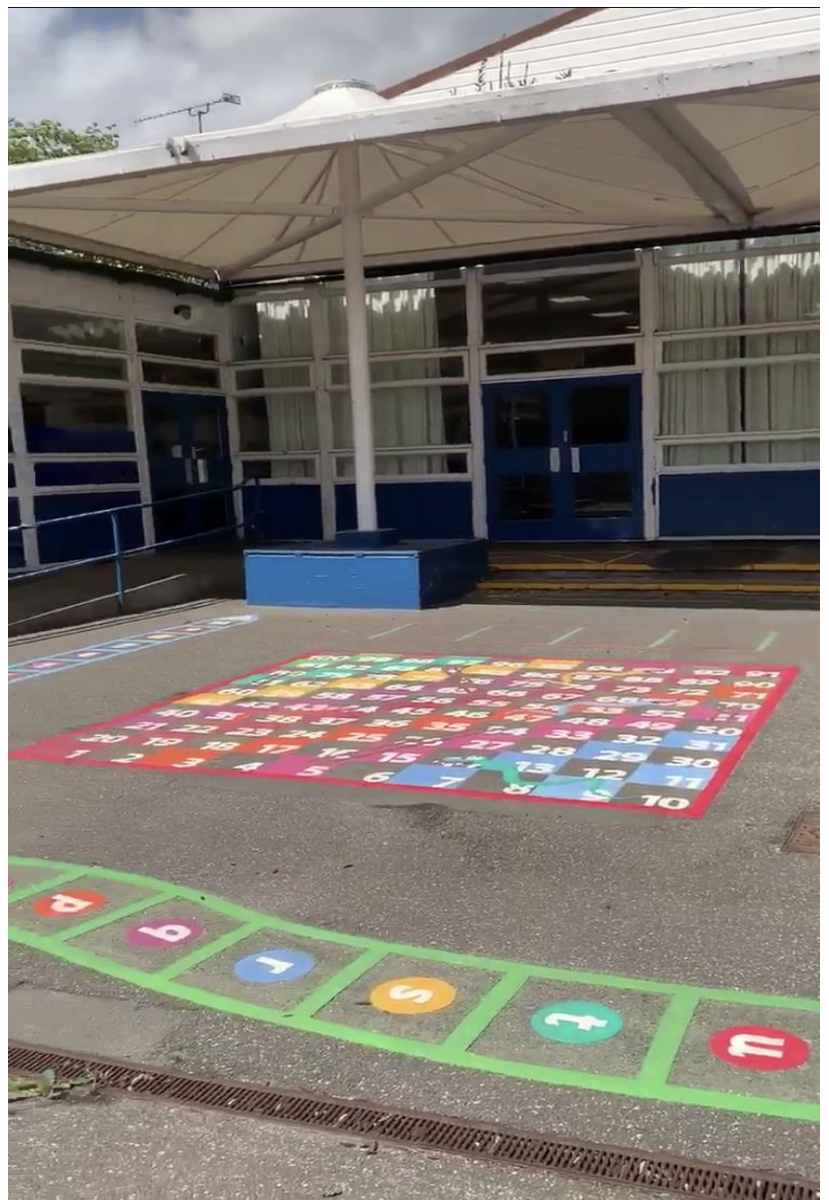


Playing outside

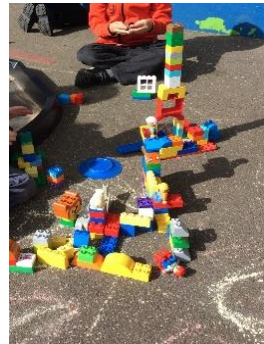
